

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF FOREST ACCESS PERMIT

Te Uranga B2 Inc and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd authorises you to enter the forest for the purpose as specified in this permit, subject to the terms and conditions of this Permit.

##### Fires:

- Lighting of fires is prohibited.
- No smoking in the forest.
- Dial 111 if you see any fire in the forest.

##### Camping:

- Camping is prohibited unless expressly permitted by this permit.

##### Hunting:

- Hunting is prohibited unless expressly permitted by this permit.

##### Firearms:

- Firearms are not permitted in the forest other than for authorised hunting or unless expressly permitted by this permit.

##### Dogs:

- Dogs are not permitted in the forest other than for authorised hunting or unless expressly permitted by this permit.
- Dogs accompanying the permit holder and those persons accompanying the permit holder will be registered by the relevant regional council.
- Dogs accompanying the permit holder and those persons accompanying the permit holder will be vaccinated for sheep measles and hydatids.
- Vaccination certificates will be carried by the permit holder and those persons accompanying the permit holder.
- On request vaccination certificates will be shown to Te Uranga B2 staff.
- At all times dogs must be under control.

##### Kiwi Aversion:

- All dogs must be trained in Kiwi aversion.

##### Poisons/Traps:

- Poisons and traps are used in the forest.
- DO NOT touch any baits, lures, carcasses or traps. Dogs are particularly susceptible to poison.
- Te Uranga B2 Inc and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd accept no responsibility for the effects of any poison.

##### Chainsaws:

- The operator of the chainsaw must be deemed competent.
- The chainsaw operator must comply with all requirements of the Approved Code of Practice for Safety and health in forest operations ([www.osh.govt.nz](http://www.osh.govt.nz)) and any health and safety requirements of the Licensor.

##### Firewood:

- The cutting and commercial sale of firewood is prohibited unless expressly permitted by this permit.

##### Trees:

- You must not cut, fell, intentionally damage, mark or remove any trees, shrubs or other forest-produce unless expressly permitted by this permit.

##### Hi-Vis Jacket:

- Must be worn by the permit holder and those persons accompanying the permit holder.

##### Hazards/Risks:

- The permit holder acknowledges that the forest is a place of potential hazards and shall take all proper care in exercising this permit including being responsible for those persons accompanying the permit holder.
- The permit holder agrees to enter the forest at their own risk and shall be solely responsible for those persons accompanying the permit holder.
- The permit holder releases to the full extent permitted by law the incorporation and the company, and their employees and agents from all liabilities, fines and demands of any kind that may arise out of any incident, accident or injury occurring to any person or property in the exercise of this permit.
- Te Uranga B2 Inc and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd makes no representation whatsoever as to the suitability of the Forest for the purpose intended by the permit holder.

##### Indemnity:

- The permit holder shall indemnify the Te Uranga B2 Inc. and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd in respect of:
  - a) Any loss, damage or injury to real property of Te Uranga B2 Inc and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd or it's contractor's;
  - b) Any loss, damage or injury to the property of Te Uranga B2 Inc. and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd or any person on the land;
  - c) All claims or actions by any third party against for any loss, damage, fines proceedings or injuries; where such loss, damages, fines or injury result from or arise out of the permit holder's presence (or those persons who accompany the permit) in the forest or from the permit holder's use of the forest tracks and roads or the undertaking of the rights under this permit.

##### Permit Requirements:

- This permit must be carried at all times and produced on demand whilst the holder is within the forest.
- This permit is not transferable and may be revoked at any time by notice given by or on behalf of Te Uranga B2 Inc. or Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd, either verbally or by written notice.
- The permit holder must comply with all reasonable directions issued by Te Uranga B2 Inc. or Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd personnel.
- The permit holder and those persons accompanying the permit holder shall not interfere with Te Uranga B2 Inc's and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd's activities in the forest or any person granted access to the forest by Te Uranga B2 Inc and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd.
- The permit holder shall not do anything or omit to do anything that may become or is an annoyance, nuisance, damage or disturbance to Te Uranga B2 Inc and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd or other occupiers or owners of land adjoining the forest.
- The permit holder shall only enter the forest along the access ways directed by Te Uranga B2 Inc and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd and shall not enter the forest except as authorised under this permit.
- The permit holder shall be responsible for the actions of all persons accompanying the permit holder under the permit whilst in the forest.
- The permit holder shall immediately notify Te Uranga B2 and Hancock Forest Management (NZ) Ltd of any damage to the forest area or any property within it or any injuries to any person occurring within the forest.

##### Breach of Permit Conditions:

- This permit will terminate upon any breach of its terms.
- In the event the permit is revoked or breached the permit holder and those persons covered by the permit shall immediately leave the forest and shall not re-enter the forest.
